

Once aboard, always pay attention to the indications and explanations from the crew or the person in charge, as well as information and danger signs located on the ship.



It is mandatory to wear a life vest at all times while aboard the ship. Make sure it fits and is tight against your body in advance, and never wear clothes on top of it. All vests are self-inflating and have a radio beacon.



Throwing any sort of waste into the sea is prohibited.



Don't lean over the railing in order to prevent falls, especially if there are swells. If you witness someone fall overboard, notify the crew by shouting "hombre al agua".



Stay in the roped off area and never interfere with fishing operations. Passenger participation in these tasks is expressly prohibited.



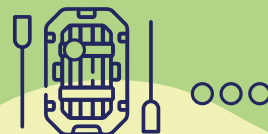
In case of emergency, you will hear alarm sounds. If you do, calmly head to the area indicated for tourists in an orderly fashion, always following the crew's instructions. Don't delay by collecting belongings.



In the case of ship evacuation, follow the crew's instructions.



The ship has a life raft with a spot reserved for each passenger. Stay calm and follow instructions before climbing aboard.



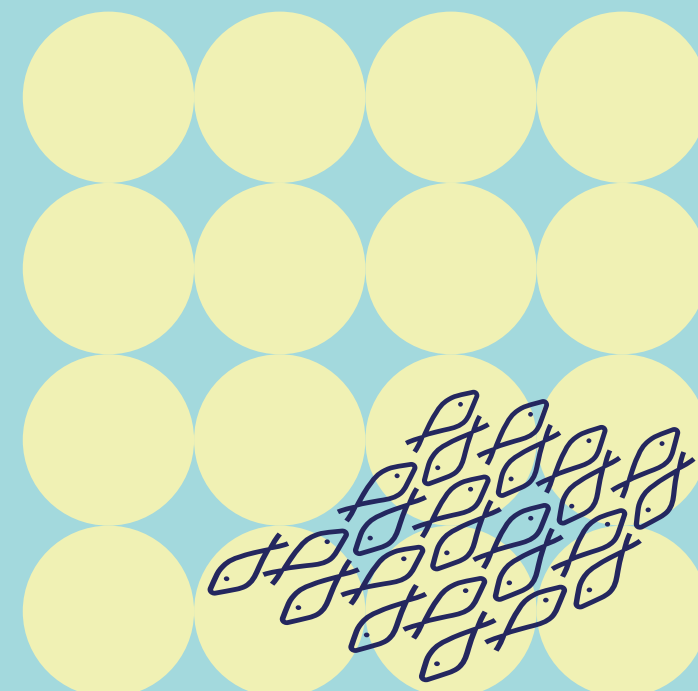

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR TOURIST FISHING ACTIVITY



Welcome to this leisure activity where you'll enjoy an unforgettable traditional fishing experience. But don't forget it's done aboard a professional vessel, so please pay close attention because, before boarding, we'll explain a few rules and recommendations, as well as all the safety measures and what to do in case of an incident.



We recommend dressing comfortably, bringing warm layers, and, if possible, a hat or cap for sun protection.



We suggest comfortable, closed-toe shoes, preferably with non-slip soles. In any case, be careful while moving around on deck or climbing stairs.



We recommend wearing sunscreen to avoid sunburn and taking motion sickness medication if you think you may need it. If you feel sick during the trip, notify the crew and follow their instructions.



It's also a good idea to be well hydrated and well rested before beginning the activity.



A fishing vessel is a workplace that carries out its activity at sea. This means that space is limited, mobile and unstable, and it's full of machinery and work equipment. Please try to bring as little with you as possible, avoiding large backpacks or bags.



You should stay in the area prepared for passenger safety, which the crew will indicate. Always follow their instructions.



The maximum authority on the ship is the captain, who can deny you access if you don't comply with the minimum requirements.



The ship has a first-aid kit exclusively for passengers that can be used if necessary, as well as liability insurance that covers all passengers throughout the experience.



There are safe means to board the ship, so you must always board and get off in the authorized area using the gangway.
